
Local Scholarship Assistance

The Concord-Carlisle Scholarship Foundation (CCSF) represents numerous clubs and organizations in the Concord and Carlisle communities which offer scholarship assistance to CCHS students for education beyond high school. This need-based financial assistance **is available to any CCHS senior or graduate.**

Each year the CCSF gives almost \$100,000 in scholarship assistance to current seniors or former CCHS graduates now in college. The funds can be used for any accredited post-secondary program, including two and four year colleges and technical schools. Students who complete the application process qualify for the CCSF scholarships solely on financial need although some local scholarships also consider factors such as college major or personal characteristics.

To apply for these scholarships, CCHS students must do the following:

- Complete a single application form from the CC Scholarship Foundation (including a short essay). This application is available on line. It is important that all information on this form be complete in order to be considered for these scholarships. The application deadline is April 1st.
- File the FAFSA and attach a copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) to the application. This form is used by the CC Scholarship Foundation to determine financial need.

It is a good idea for families to complete the FAFSA information as soon as financial information is generally known. Waiting to submit the FAFSA until the actual April 15 deadline for filing tax returns is likely to jeopardize financial assistance from both CCHS and college-based scholarship sources.

Caroline E. Hill Scholarship Fund

The **Caroline E. Hill Scholarship Fund**, which offers financial assistance to Carlisle students, requires a separate application form along with the Financial Aid PROFILE. Use **CSS Code #0520** when completing the PROFILE. The application can be obtained in the CCHS Records Office after the December vacation and **must be returned to the Carlisle Board of Selectmen.**
